International applicants can be enrolled to a bachelor/master/specialist /doctoral degree programme on fee paying (contractual) basis and on places funded by the Russian Government (the scholarship covers tuition fees and entitles to obtain academic scholarships and a place at the SPbU halls of residence in an amount specified for Russian students of government funded programmes.
